### Intensive Behavioral Health Services (IBHS) starts in January

Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) is being replaced by IBHS in January. The change will have a one year transition. This change will not affect current BHRS authorizations.

- All current BHRS authorizations will remain open
- No BHRS may be provided after January 17, 2021

We are working closely with the Dept. of Human Services (DHS) to start IBHS. There are changes from BHRS and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA). We know you will have questions. We want this change to be as easy as possible for you. Our website has information from past IBHS meetings. You can visit the DHS website for helpful resources (see below). You can also contact your Magellan care manager.

#### IBHS definition:1

- IBHS are interventions and supports for children, youth or young adults under the age of 21 with mental, emotional or behavioral health needs
- IBHS can be provided in the home, school or other community setting
- IBHS includes individual services, ABA services, group services and evidence-based treatment (EBT) provided through individual services, ABA services or group services

#### How was IBHS formed:1

- IBHS was created when a diverse stakeholder group came together to talk about regulating BHRS
- Stakeholders included family members, providers, and other parties involved in delivering BHRS

#### Key points for families:

- You should expect all BHRS/ABA providers to accept calls from families that are seeking IBHS
- BHRS will continue to be offered through Magellan's network of providers until there are a sufficient amount of IBHS contracted providers
- A full IBHS network is scheduled by January, 2021
- As BHRS authorizations expire, youth will be considered for IBHS
- If clinically appropriate, the youth will be recommended for IBHS and a new authorization will be submitted
- Our online provider search and provider directory will be updated to include IBHS providers as they are contracted
- We do not anticipate any disruption in your services
