

New Crisis Center Opened on November 1 in Cambria County

Nulton Diagnostic & Treatment Center, in collaboration with Cambria County Board of Commissioners, Behavioral Health of Cambria County (BHOCC), Cambria County Behavioral Health Services Program, Breaking the Barriers, and Magellan Behavioral Health of Pennsylvania, opened the REACH Crisis Walkin Center on November 1, located at 110 Franklin Street, Suite 105, Johnstown, PA 15901. This new Crisis Center provides both walk-in services and 24/7 mobile crisis services for immediate response to individuals and families in Cambria County seeking mental health crisis intervention in a safe and welcoming environment.

The REACH Crisis Walk-in Center is designed to serve a diverse range of individuals residing in Cambria County who are experiencing a mental health crisis or are in need of immediate mental health support. The target population of the Crisis Center includes:

- Children: Typically aged between 5 and 17, who may be experiencing a mental health crisis or require urgent support. This includes addressing concerns related to mood disorders, anxiety, ADHD, autism spectrum disorders, and other mental health challenges. Child-focused interventions and support will be provided by professionals with experience in child and adolescent mental health.
- **Adults**: Aged 18 to 64, experiencing a wide range of mental health concerns, such as depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, PTSD, and substance use disorders. Services will be tailored to address the unique needs and challenges faced by adults in crisis.
- *Older Adults*: Aged 65 and over, who may be dealing with age-specific mental health challenges, including cognitive decline, dementia, depression, anxiety, and adjustment to age-related changes. Staff members with expertise in geriatric mental health will ensure that services are tailored to the unique needs of older adults.
