## Bucks Human Services Hub Services

The vision of The Hub is for Bucks County residents, their families, and those who support them to be aware of and have access to human services resources in person and virtually through a person-centered, supportive, integrated experience.

The core service of the Hub is Resource Navigation:, meant to help coach those in need navigate the process of Identifying and obtaining vital human services, an often long, difficult, and arduous process to navigate alone. We are here to help! Includes goal-setting & light-touch case management



## **COMPASS Community Partner**

In late 2024, The Hub established an official partnership with COMPASS, PA's online welfare The Hub's Resource Navigators can now directly take welfare applications instead of being referred to COMPASS or the Bucks County Assistance Office. The Hub is one of the extreme few providers in the County who can help individuals apply directly for assistance (SNAP benefits, healthcare, etc.). ## SOAR

As of 2025, Hub staff became certified in SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access, and Recover (SOAR), and the Hub is now a SOAR Works! provider. SOAR is intended to help states and communities end homelessness for adults with serious mental illness (SMI) through increased access to Social Security disability benefits. The SOAR "Process" is intended to expedite the lengthy process of obtaining social security benefits for those experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity, and living with a mental health or substance abuse disorder and unable to maintain substantial gainful employment due to a behavioral health and/or physical disability.



## Pet Assistance

The Hub leads BPIN, which is a coalition bringing animal welfare, advocates, vet medicine, and human services providers together to keep people and pets together. Our goals include creation of co-sheltering in emergency shelters; access to necessary vet care for those who cannot afford it; help with rental pet deposits and fees, and much more. Those in need of services for their pet and cannot afford it (such as supplies, food, vet care, etc.) should contact the Hub for referrals and services.
