

PRS appointments available through MATP – Effective January 1, 2026

Starting on January 1, 2026, the Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP) may provide rides to and from a member's Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services (PRS) appointment. This document [here](#) provides the notification details and key points of contact for members and their supports. PRS providers should share this important information with members.

What is MATP?

- Transportation is available to almost any service that the Medical Assistance Program pays for.
- Transportation can be provided to physicians, dentists, health clinics, podiatrists, rural health clinics, hospice programs, physical therapists, outpatient services, pharmacies, drug and alcohol clinics, mental health centers, outpatient rehabilitation services, optometrists, dialysis clinics, psychologists, ambulatory surgical services, and now PRS.
- Services that MATP does not include are emergency or other transportation requiring an ambulance, transportation to sheltered workshops, day care programs, transportation for visitation purposes, stretcher service, door-through-door service, transportation to non-medical services, transportation during severe weather when deemed unsafe or transportation to any medical services that are not payable through the Medical Assistance Program.
