Participants will gain insights into suicide prevention, risk formulation, and the foundational elements of the CAMS model.

Session 2: Mastering Drivers Focused Care Training

This 3-hour in-person afternoon session, led by Dr. Melinda Moore focuses on using CAMS in interim care sessions including the latest innovations and research on “Drivers” focused care. Clinicians will have the opportunity to observe clinical demonstrations and participate in an interactive role play exercise. This course will also introduce clinicians to the CAMS Rating Scale, as well as optional CAMS tools for treating common suicidal drivers such as the CAMS Therapeutic Worksheet.

This training is designed for those who’ve completed all or most requirements to becoming CAMS Trained and is intended for clinicians looking to expand their expertise in utilizing CAMS interim care and is highly recommended for those seeking to become CAMS Certified™.
