

Magellan's Bethlehem Care Management Center hosts food drive and pet drive for local organizations

From Oct. 29 to Nov. 16, Magellan employees from the Bethlehem Care Management Center participated in a food drive and pet drive to help local organizations in the Lehigh Valley. The food drive collected non-perishable food items for the [Second Harvest Food Bank of Lehigh Valley & Northeast Pennsylvania](#) (a program of the Community Action Committee of the Lehigh Valley), located in Nazareth, PA. The pet drive collected animal shelter donations for [The Center for Animal Health & Welfare](#), located in Easton, PA. Magellan also contributed \$135 to each organization, in addition to the donations collected in its office.

Here is some additional information on these organizations:

The Second Harvest Food Bank distributes food and grocery products to more than 200 member agencies in Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton, Pike and Wayne counties. Agencies include emergency food pantries, child care and rehabilitation centers, soup kitchens and shelters. Thanks to their dedicated staff, hundreds of volunteers, and kind donors, Second Harvest distributed over 9 million pounds of food last year and currently provides food assistance to more than 60,000 individuals every month through their member agencies.

The Center for Animal Health & Welfare is a non-profit, 501(c)3 organization located in Northampton County that was formerly the Northampton County SPCA. In 2003, they officially became a no-kill shelter.
