

Magellan employees collect over 1,700 pounds of food for the 16th Annual Thanksgiving Food Drive in Delaware County

The 16th Annual Delaware County Thanksgiving Food Drive, from Oct. 1 through Dec. 7, was once again a team effort of community-focused leaders and providers coming together to help those less fortunate feed their families. This county-wide effort to address food insecurity for those relying on food centers for their survival is organized by Delaware County Council, Delaware County Department of Human Services, Delaware County Department of Intercommunity Health and Magellan Behavioral Health of Pennsylvania (Magellan). All proceeds benefit the Delco Inter-Faith Food Assistance Network (DIFAN) of Family and Community Service.
