

Waived and Suspended Licensing Regulations

Magellan continues to work closely with our County partners to obtain clarification and guidance from OMHSAS regarding the announcement earlier this month concerning waived and suspended licensing regulations, including the status of telehealth after September 30, 2021. We want to support providers in the development of strategies that minimize service disruptions for members and stabilize the service delivery system. It is anticipated that we will forward additional communications in the coming weeks as we receive updates from OMHSAS.
